

What do the pictograms mean?

Pictograms are graphical representations of the type of hazard that a chemical product is classified as. There are a total of 9 pictograms prescribed by GHS. They are:

 Flammable	 Oxidizer	 Explosive
 Gases under pressure	 Corrosive	 Toxic to human health
 Harmful, irritating, or causes allergic skin reactions	 May cause allergic respiratory reactions, cancer, genetic defects, toxic to reproduction, or aspiration hazards	 Toxic to aquatic life (both acute and chronic)
